

FLEXSIGMOIDOSCOPY PREPARATION

DAY OF SCOPE

Your child may have nothing to eat after midnight except clear liquids which may be given up to 3 hours prior to the procedure. Clear liquids may include: water, Sprite, 7UP, Gatorade, Powerade, Propel, Pedialyte and Kool-Aid (nothing red or purple). The patient may brush their teeth.

For patients under 2 years of age

Give ½ **pediatric** Fleet enema the morning of the procedure. This should be given 2 hours before leaving home.

For patients between 2-8 years of age

Give 1 pediatric Fleet enema the morning of the procedure. This should be given 2 hours before leaving home.

For patients 9+ years of age

Give 1 adult Fleet enema the morning of the procedure. This should be given 2 hours before leaving your home.

*Medications listed are available over the counter and may be purchased at your local pharmacy.

*The patient must bring a driver the day of the procedure. The patient may not drive for 24 hours after the procedure.

*Please ask for school and work excuses prior to discharge from the recovery room.

AFTER YOU GO HOME

- Have the patient take it easy for the remainder of the day.
- Start a regular diet later that night.
- Allow the patient to go to school and resume regular activities the next day unless the doctor states otherwise.
- The patient may experience a minor sore throat or gas pains that should go away within 24 hours.
