REDUCE THE RISK



1 IN 5 pregnant women experience maternal mental health conditions, like depression, anxiety, OCD, PTSD, bipolar or substance use disorders, which may increase the risk of premature birth.



between delivery and becoming pregnant again increases risk of preterm birth



Maternal diabetes, high blood pressure, high BMI and drug use, including smoking and vaping, increase the RISK OF PRETERM BIRTH



Rate of prenatal smoking in Ohio
